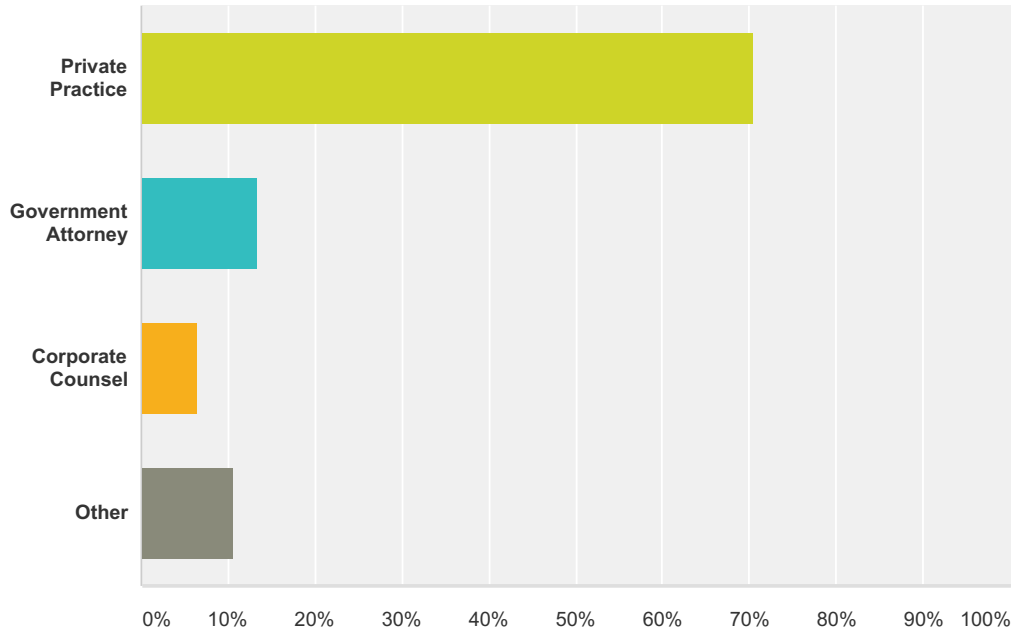


### Q1 What is the nature of your practice?

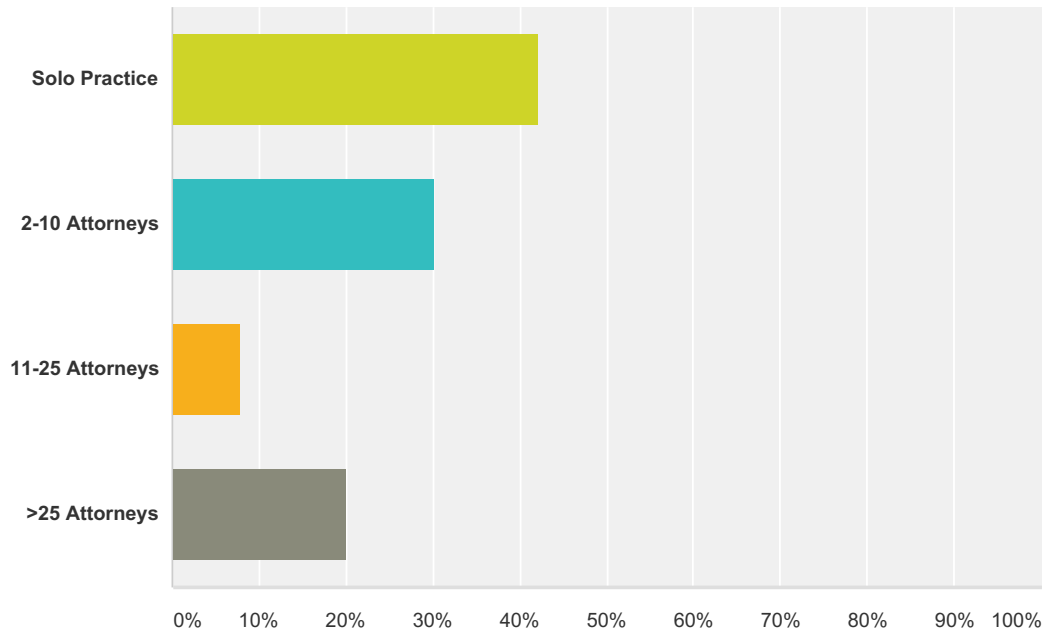

## Q2 If in private practice what is the size of your firm?

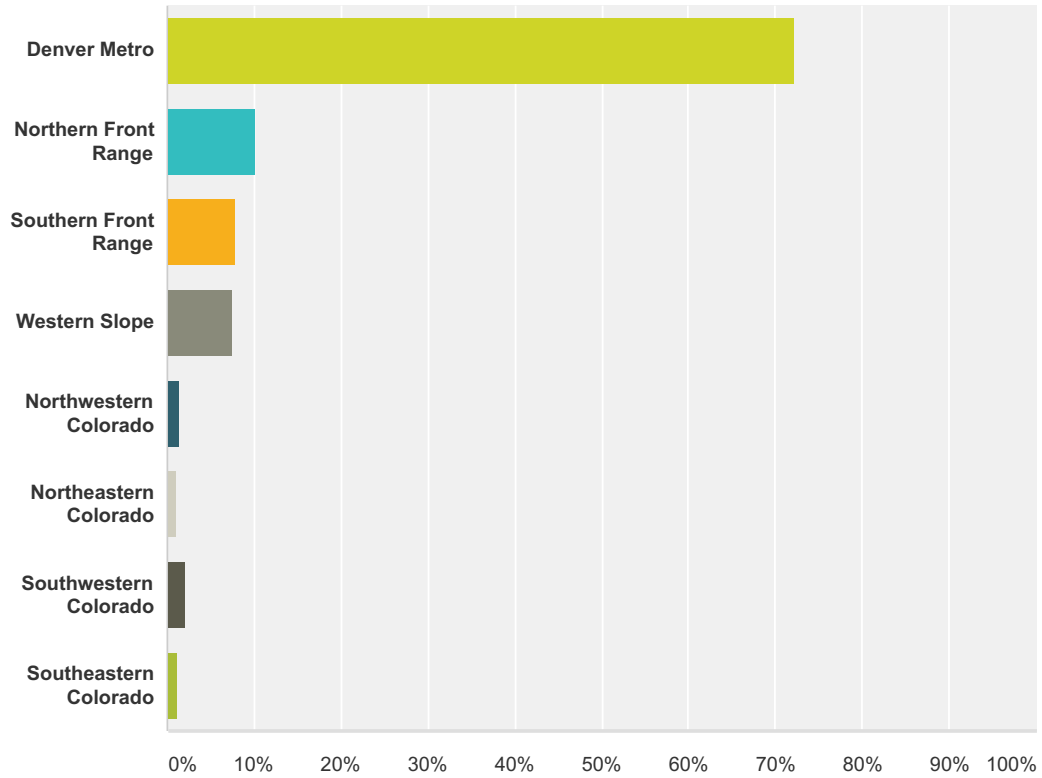

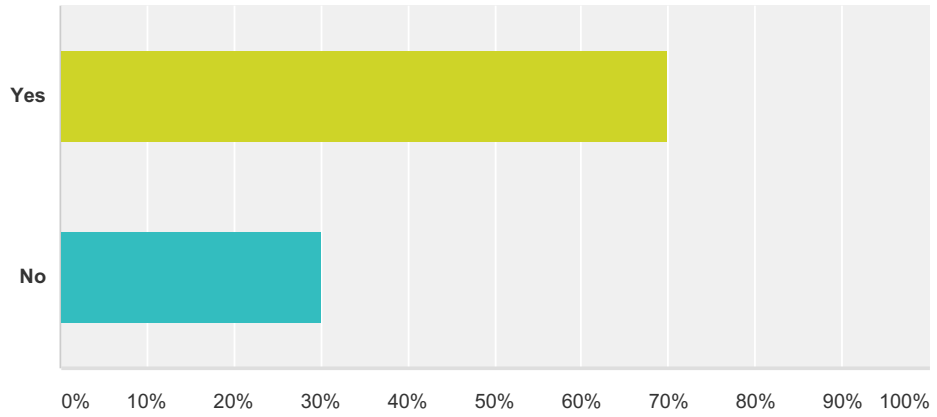

## Q4 Do you do pro bono work?

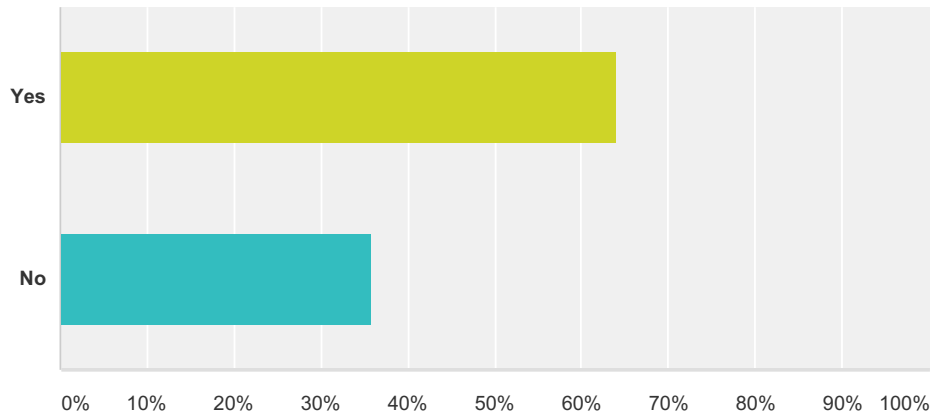

### Q5 Do you do pro bono work for persons of limited means?

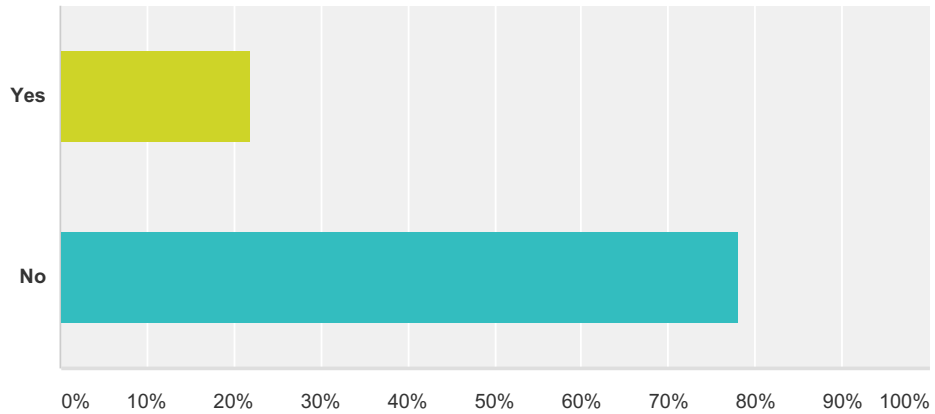

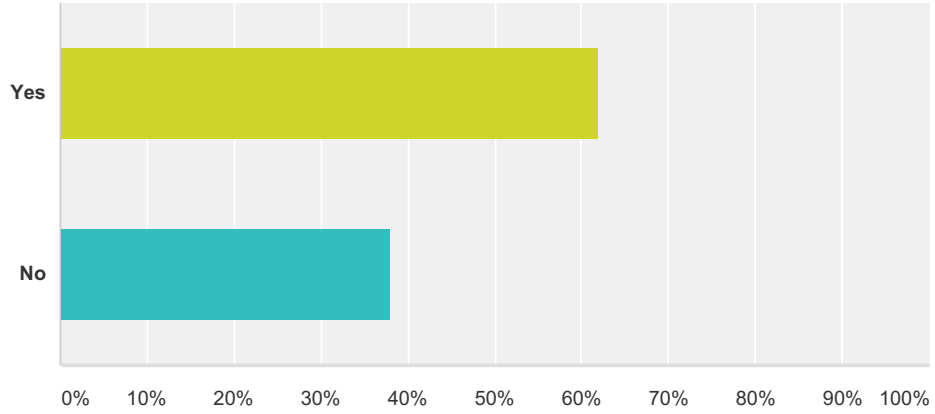

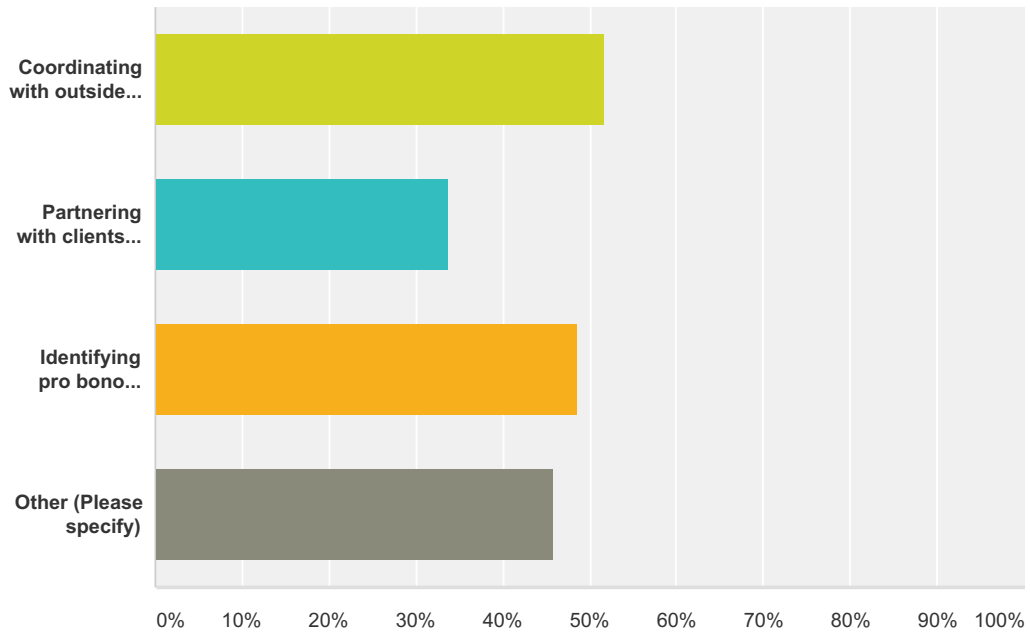


**Q9 If yes, for how many years has your firm met its commitment?**

### Q10 What steps has your firm taken to meet its commitment?

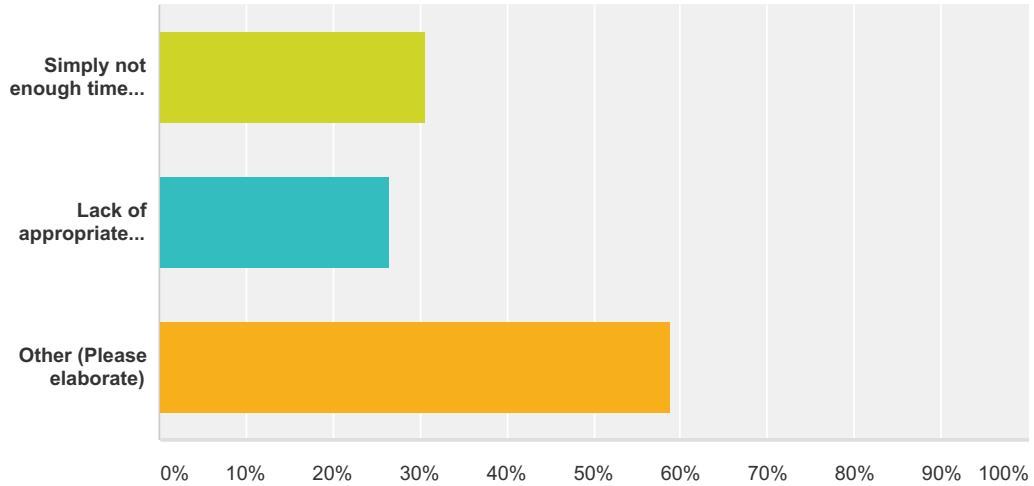

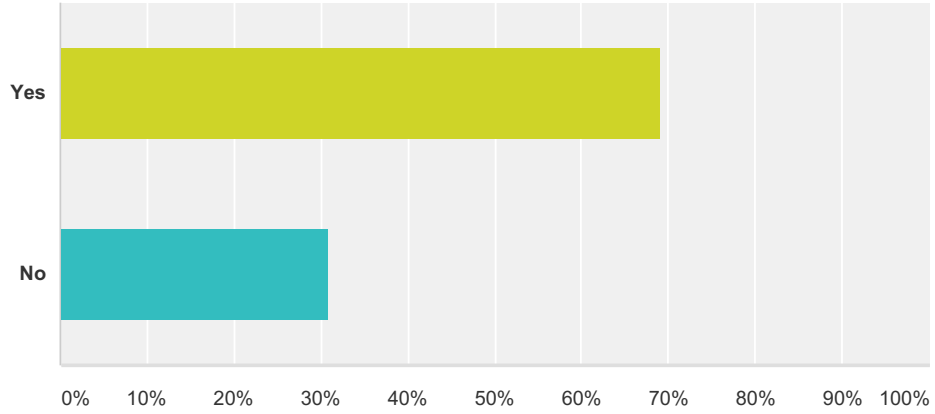

## Q12 Does your firm or employer do pro bono work, even though it has not made the commitment?

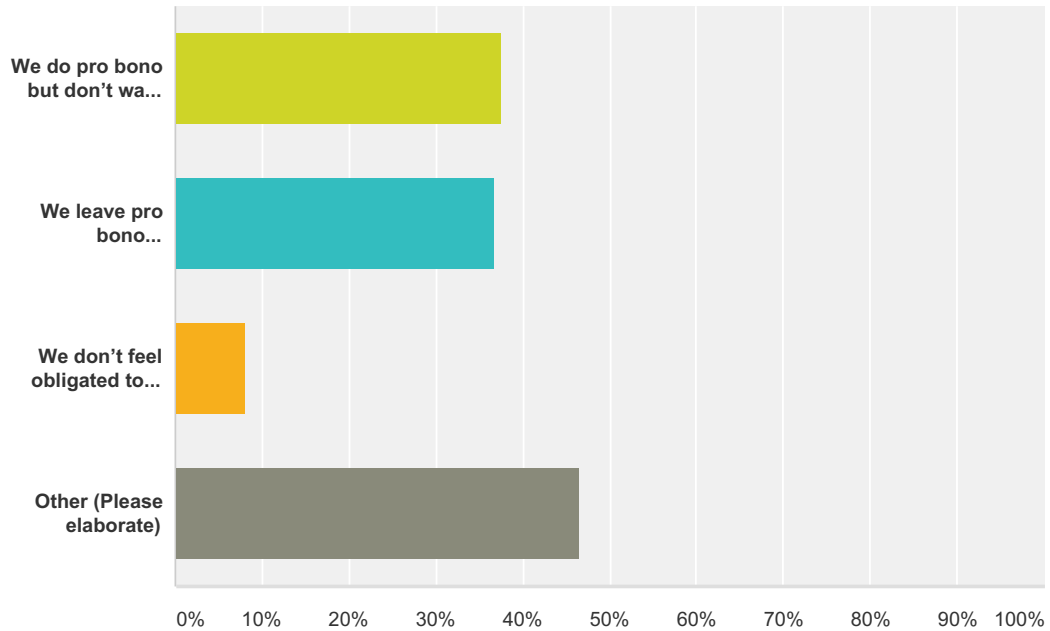
